NATIONAL HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH
SEPTEMBER 15, 2017-OCTOBER 15, 2017**

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States through Public Law 100-402, authorizes and requests the President to annually proclaim that September 15 to October 15, is designated as “National Hispanic Heritage Month,” and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Month is intended to broaden and increase the awareness of the many Hispanic contributions to American culture, to show how diversified the Hispanic community is and to promote a greater interest in young people as to the Hispanic history and culture; and

WHEREAS, the Hispanic enrichment to our Nation in music, arts, sciences, education, business and trade is evident in American culture and, in particular, in California; and

WHEREAS, today there are more than 14 million Hispanics in California who are contributing to California’s success by playing leading roles in agriculture, medicine, science, entertainment, business, sports and education; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Americans have helped to shape our national character and strengthen our communities through the warmth and vitality of their culture.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Central Unified School District does hereby recognize September 15, 2017, to October 15, 2017 as National Hispanic Heritage Month and encourages all Central Unified School District schools and the Central community to observe this month with appropriate and meaningful ceremonies and activities, based on the 2017 theme “Shaping the Bright Future of America.”
