

A brief introduction to 21st Century High School After School Safety and Enrichment for Teens (ASSETs) Programs

ASSETs is a state-administered federally funded program providing 5 year grant funds. Programs offer expanded learning opportunities focused on supporting academic achievement including college and career readiness for high school youth.

- **Serving grades 9-12**
- **Operates a minimum of 15 hours per week, 180 days per school year**
- **Provides academic assistance including, but not limited to, tutoring in core subject areas, homework assistance, college preparation, and helping youth develop knowledge and skills related to career interests and aligned with academic content**
- **Provides enrichment activities including, but not limited to, service learning, tutoring younger youth, career technical education, visual and performing arts, and physical fitness**
- **Maximum annual grant award of \$250,000 for 5 years (working budget \$215,368)**
- **Funding levels are maintained by reaching 85% of attendance goals annually**
