

INSTRUCTION

Student Assessment

The Superintendent or designee recognizes that student assessments are an important instructional and accountability tool. Assessment data shall be used to help determine individual students' progress, mastery of academic standards, appropriate placement in district programs, and eligibility for graduation. In addition, pursuant to Education Code 52060, summary data on student assessment results shall be used by the district to identify and review student achievement goals in the district's local control and accountability plan, evaluate district educational programs in order to identify needed improvements, and as, appropriate, evaluate staff performance.

For the purposes of evaluation of staff performance, staff includes Superintendent, certificated management and teachers.

Assessment data will be used to evaluate staff performance as outlined in Article 11 of the CUTA Collective Bargaining agreement. Staff performance will be addressed as outlined in the California Standards of the Teaching Profession (CSTP's).
