*Establish a Guidance Committee that represents the students served in Central Unified for the purpose of examining:*

- *Effectiveness of LCAP actions*
- *Stakeholder input*
- *Accountability Dashboard*
- *Alignment of resources*

*Guidance Committee shall be comprised of the following individuals:*

- Parents: 20 parents that represent significant subgroups proportional to our demographics
  - 66% Socioeconomically disadvantaged
  - 12% English Learners
  - 1% Foster
  - 10% SPED
  - % GATE
- Demographics:
  - 19% Hispanic
  - 6% Punjabi
  - 3 % Hmong
  - Other: African American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Filipino, White
- Employee Groups:
  - 3 CUTA members (1 each grade span)
  - 3 CESA members (representing different departments)
- Student Groups:
  - 3 Middle School (1 per campus)
  - 3 High School
- Administrators
  - 3 Site Level Admin (1 each grade span)
- Support Staff - Districtwide
  - 1 Representative – Homeless/Foster Advocate
  - 1 Representative – Parent Involvement
  - 1 Representative – Students with Disabilities & Support Services
  - 1 Representative – Technology
  - 1 Representative – Transportation / Executive Services
